Power Cost Adjustment

The Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) for December is \$0.0042l/kilowatt-hour. This amounts to an additional \$4.2l per 1,000 kilowatt-hours.

The PCA was implemented in 2002 to cover only the increase (or decrease) in power costs (over and above 7¢/kwh) charged to us by our wholesale power supplier, Kansas Electric Power Cooperative (KEPCo) in Topeka. The PCA varies each month depending on the wholesale charges from KEPCo and is a flow-through on your electric bill.

Ice Storm Causes Outages

At about 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 27, freezing temperatures and rain began to form ice on trees across our service territory. The weight of the ice on the trees caused limbs to break and pull down the service lines to hundreds of Caney Valley members. Due to the large number of individual service outages, the cooperative requested additional line crews and tree clearing contractor crews from other companies to help restore power.

Rain continued into the night, hampering restoration efforts. Many members were without power Tuesday night and into Wednesday evening. By Thursday evening, the outages were much more manageable. On Friday afternoon, only a small number remained. A list of areas affected during the outage is included on Page 16B.
